Didintle Blessing Tladi (18), the accused in the case, has been in custody since his arrest. The case has seen several delays.

According to Sivenathi Gunya, communications officer for the National Prosecuting Authority (North West Division), the matter was again postponed on Thursday, 20 June 2025. The postponement comes as the defence intends to apply for bail based on new facts. Contrary to earlier expectations, the case has not yet been transferred to a regional court for trial and remains in the district court while the bail application process unfolds.

TINY OWL GETS A SECOND CHANCE



Rescued just in time!

This little pearl-spotted owlet, found weak and injured in Swartruggens, is now safe and healing thanks to the swift response of wildlife rescuers.

Swartruggens - Sometimes, the smallest creatures have the biggest stories. On 30 May 2025, a fragile pearl-spotted owlet (nonnie uil) was discovered at the Swartruggens mills - underweight, injured, and alone. But thanks to quick-thinking community members and the dedication of Timothy Strydom from P.D.I. Wildlife Rescue, the tiny owl's fate changed for the better.

Despite a long day's work, Strydom didn't hesitate. "Its toe was injured, and it was thin," he said. Without delay, he transported the owlet to a rehabilitation centre for urgent care. Now, the young bird is in safe hands at the Owl Rescue Centre in Hartbeespoort, receiving ongoing treatment and attention.

This heartwarming rescue highlights the important work done by P.D.I. Wildlife Rescue, an organisation led by Debbie van den Berg, which assists with wildlife rescues in Swartruggens, Groot Marico, Zeerust, Rustenburg, and surrounding areas.

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FOOT AND MOUTH DISEASE ALERT!

North West Province - The North West Department of Agriculture and Rural Development confirmed on 16 June 2025 that Foot and Mouth Disease (FMD) has been detected in the province, with confirmed outbreaks in the Dr Kenneth Kaunda District, specifically within the JB Marks Local Municipality. Follow-up investigations are also now underway closer to home in Rustenburg.

The first case was reported by a private veterinarian who noticed suspicious symptoms on a farm. State veterinarians were dispatched, and samples confirmed the presence of the disease after testing at the Onderstepoort Veterinary Institute.

A second incident was uncovered at an abattoir in Madibeng during post-mortem meat inspection, after being missed at the ante-mortem stage. Tests revealed the presence of both SAT 2 and SAT 3 types of the virus. Unslaughtered animals were traced back to a Ventersdorp feedlot and safely returned under Red Cross permit. Both affected farms are now under strict quarantine.

The Department has placed all farms linked to the broader Gauteng outbreak under precautionary quarantine, pending test results

Foot and Mouth Disease is a highly contagious viral illness that affects cattle, pigs, goats, sheep, and other clovenhoofed animals. Symptoms include fever, lameness, and painful sores on the mouth, feet, and teats

Locally, state veterinary officials are expected in the Avondale area near Rustenburg starting 19 June 2025. This is part of a follow-up response to a suspected local case. Premises within a 5-kilometre radius of location M35 will be visited. Site inspections and sample collection will be carried out by:

Farmers and animal handlers are encouraged to use a basic disinfectant mix to clean equipment and shoes. According to state veterinary officials, a solution made by diluting household bleach (Jik) or Surf powder at a 1:10 ratio (1L to 10L water) is effective. This method is recommended in official government guidelines.

AND A TRIBUTE TO ITS FIRST CHAIRMAN, PROFESSOR PAUL FATTI



Professor Paul Fatti

Rustenburg - On Monday 9 June 2025, we proudly celebrate a decade since the Magaliesberg Biosphere Reserve was officially designated by UNESCO, under their Man and Biosphere Programme. A milestone for all who cherish this unique and ancient landscape and none more so than Professor Paul Fatti, a steadfast champion of the Magaliesberg Mountains, a core area of the biosphere. Ten years ago, Professor Fatti was part of the South African delegation that travelled to UNESCO headquarters in Paris to witness the designation of the Magaliesberg Biosphere. But that moment, historic as it was, marked only one step in a determined journey of over 50 years!

From his early years as chairman of the Mountain Club of South Africa to his leadership in the Magaliesberg Protection Association, Paul has been at the forefront of conservation efforts in the Magaliesberg Mountains. His influence has shaped both policy and public awareness. In 1977, thanks in large part to Paul's tireless lobbying, the high ground of the Magaliesberg was proclaimed the first "Natural Area" in South Africa under the Physical Planning Act. This landmark achievement laid the foundation for further protections under the

Environmental Conservation Act of 1989 and later the National Environmental Management Protected Areas Act of 2003, under which the Magaliesberg was designated a "Protected Environment".

Inspired by the 1999 inscription of the Cradle of Humankind as a UNESCO World Heritage Site, Paul joined Vincent Carruthers and others in a bold vision: to secure international recognition for the entire region. Their campaign, supported by the NW Province, Gauteng and the Department of Environment. ultimately led to the declaration of the Magaliesberg Biosphere Reserve - a globally recognised model for reconciling biodiversity conservation with sustainable land use.

Today, Paul Fatti continues to serve on the Board of the Biosphere, bringing decades of knowledge, passion, and hope for the future.

On this special day, we extend gratitude for Paul's legacy of leadership, resilience, and belief in the Magaliesberg's irreplaceable value. And to the Biosphere, we say: here's to the next ten years of protection, progress, and promise.

FIRE SEASON – Are you prepared...?

Rustenburg - After a severe 2024 fire season with devastating runaway wildfires, the Greater Rustenburg Fire Protection Association (GRFPA) would like to bring to the landowners' attention the following: The National Veldfire Act of 1998 stipulates the responsibilities and legal obligations of landowners in the prevention and combating of wildfires. We urge all landowners to visit the GRFPA website at grfpa. org and familiarise themselves with the provisions of the Act.

With the abundant rain our region had during the past summer, the veld has grown thick and lush. This is great but in the same breath worrisome. We have a high "fuel load" for wildfires and preparations need to be made to safeguard structures, animal enclosures, pasture fields etc. Are you prepared?

These laws are not only applicable to outlying farms and rural areas, but also to those living on the urban edge. What happened in Los Angeles and Cape Town earlier in the year, could easily happen in our region. We had a close encounter last year when the Kgaswane Reserve fire threatened town

We urge you, as patrons of Rustenburg, to be cautious and vigilant. Currently, the farmers are preparing their firebreaks for the season and a lot of smoke is noticeable. As of the 1st of July 2025, a Burn

Permit is required to conduct any burns subject to the Fire Danger Index. These are available from the Fire Brigade and members of the GRFPA can apply via the GRFPA portal.

Let us unite as one in the combatting of these devastating fires. When out on a hike, visiting parks or having an outdoor braai - only make a fire in a safe location dedicated for such. Do not throw cigarette butts out of the window or into the veld. Do not start a fire without the necessary permissions and equipment to control such.

Be kind to yourself, your neighbours, your community and nature - DON'T START FIRES!
