

MULTI-STAKEHOLDER OUTREACH PROGRAMME BRINGS SERVICES CLOSER TO THE PEOPLE OF PHATSIMA

Rustenburg Local Municipality, together with key government stakeholders, conducted a community outreach programme in Phatsima aimed at improving access to essential services and engaging directly with residents on matters affecting their daily lives.

The outreach programme was attended by officials from the Department of Health, Department of Social Development, Department of Arts, Sports and Culture, as well as the South African Social Security Agency (SASSA), who collectively provided a range of services and information to members of the community.

The Department of Health offered basic health screening services and health awareness information, while the Department of Social Development engaged with vulnerable groups and provided support services aimed at improving social wellbeing within the community.

The Department of Arts, Sports and Culture highlighted programmes focused on youth development, community participation and social cohesion through arts, sports and cultural initiatives. SASSA officials were also on site to assist residents with social grant-related enquiries and provide guidance on available social support programmes.

The outreach forms part of ongoing efforts to ensure that government services are accessible to communities and to strengthen collaboration between departments in addressing socio-economic challenges facing residents.
