WASTE MANAGEMENT

The Rustenburg Local Municipality (RLM) Integrated Waste Management Plan (IWMP) was developed in 2006. The review of the IWMP is prepared to align the Plan with new developments in the South African Waste Management Legislation as well as to assess progress to date and chart a way forward.

The draft IWMP was tabled to the Municipal Council on the 02 May 2017 per item 115, in line with section 127 of the Local Government: Municipal Finance Management Act, Act 56 of 2003.

The enactment of the National Environmental Management: Waste Act (Act 59 of 2008) (NEMWA) made the development of IWMP a mandatory requirement. Section 4(a)(i) of NEMWA states that each Municipality should prepare and submit an IWMP to the relevant MEC for approval. The main aim of Integrated Waste Management (IWM) planning is to optimise waste management by maximising efficiency, and minimising associated environmental impacts and financial costs.

In pursuance of the provisions of the Act mentioned above, members of Community within the jurisdictional area of Rustenburg Local Municipality are hereby invited to submit representations in connection with the draft IWMP.

The Rustenburg Local Municipality, Waste Management Unit invites members of the Public / Local communities to review the IWMP and its associated documents and/ or participate in a series of consultative meetings on the draft IWMP of the Rustenburg Local Municipality.

The purpose of this process is to obtain inputs from Members of the Public on the draft IWMP, thereby enhancing governance processes and service delivery efficiency within the Municipality. The schedule of meetings is indicated below.
