Qualification Requirements for Life Guards:

Grade 12, A valid first Aid Certificate, swimming competency certificate (Re-test Card), valid Life Guard award (Pool) certificate, Excellent swimmer and higher level of physical fitness, able to work weekends and on public holidays, able to work individually and within the team. Practical testing will also be done

Duties

- Maintains constant surveillance of swimmers in the facility and act immediately
- Secure safety of swimmers in the event of emergency
- Provides emergency care and treatment as required until arrival of emergency care
- Presents professional appearance and attitude at all times and maintain a high standard of customer service
- Perform various maintenance duties as directed
- Maintain a clean and safe facility eg testing of pool water and adding chemicals
- Be capable of handling cash as and when required for relief cashier duties
- Prevent unlawful conduct, theft and/or misuse of alcohol on the premises.
- Write reports on any incidents that may occur
- Performs miscellaneous job – related duties as assigned by Management

Additional hours may be applicable during events like swimming galas, etc. Please note that part-time life guards are only for seasonal occasions.


These positions are not permanent ones, and the successful candidates will be required to sign a Contract of Part-time Employment.
