RE: 2021 LOCAL GOVERNMENT ELECTIONS – RELAXATION OF THE RUSTENBURG LOCAL MUNICIPALITY'S OUTDOOR ADVERTISING BY-LAWS

The South African Local Government Association (SALGA) has issued Circular 14/2021 requesting the relaxation of Outdoor Advertising By-laws for the sole purposes of preparing for the 2021 Local Government Elections.

In terms of Rustenburg Local Municipality Outdoor Advertising By-laws of 2019, part 4; which relates to Exemptions, Exclusions and Withdrawals under the Temporary Advertising Signs; provision or consent is given to political parties to erect temporary election posters. This is for a reasonable period leading to the elections. Political parties are obliged to remove the advertising materials erected within the stipulated period after the elections have been finalised.

Furthermore; in terms of this By-Law, you are required to comply with the following conditions:

1. Parties should submit applications on the prescribed form to inform the Municipality of the intention to advertise/display posters for administrative purposes, indicating the number and locations of the election posters
2. Up to a hundred posters may be erected
3. Posters should be brought to the office for departmental stamp as proof of approval
