**CALLING ALL EMERGING CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTORS
INVITATION FOR TRAINING AND DEVELOPMENT OF EMERGING
CONTRACTORS THROUGH THE RUSTENBURG LOCAL MUNICIPALITY'S EPWP
VUK'UPHILE LEARNERSHIP PROGRAMME**

Rustenburg Local Municipality, in partnership with the Department of Public Works and Infrastructure, is embarking on a training programme for contractors under the auspices of the Expanded Public Works Vuk'uphile Learnership Programme. The primary objective of this structured, formal learnership programme is to develop emerging contractors into sustainable construction entities with the ability to execute and oversee labour-intensive projects. In particular, the focus will be on developing entrepreneurial/business, administrative, contract management and technical skills.

Our first interest is in historically disadvantaged individuals who have the potential to succeed within the construction industry, and we would particularly like to hear from individuals who:

- are experienced in the construction sector;
- are experienced in owning, running or managing a business; and
- Youth, Women and People leaving with Disabilities are encouraged to apply.

1. SELECTION CRITERIA

1.1. Prospective construction entities must attach:

- Central Supplier Database compliant summary report;
- Company registration documents;
- Copy of valid CIDB registration documents within Grades 1CE, 2CE, 1GB or 2 GB;
- Copy of valid BBBEE Certificate / Certified affidavit;
- Copy of valid certified SA Identity Document; and
- Proof of Residence from Ward Councillor or Municipal Account or Tribal authority

1.2. Prospective contractors must:

- Be literate and numerate in English and Mathematics respectively;
- Be a local resident within Rustenburg Local Municipality;
- Be willing to enter into a full-time, for a period not less than twenty four (24) months, learnership contract for a relevant qualification at National Qualification Framework (NQF) Level 4); and
- Have a minimum of Grade 12 (Standard 10) and/or obtain recognition of prior learning by the closing date of the advert.





1.3. Assessment of prospective contractors

Assessment of prospective contractors shall be conducted with consideration of the following:

- Occupational Health and Safety Act No.85 of 1993, with regard to Health and Safety requirements on a construction site.
- Employment Equity Act 55 of 1998, to distinguish, exclude or prefer any person on the basis of inherent requirements of the job.

1.4. Selection

Final selection will be based on written test results, interview results, affirmative action, and qualifications.
